



Regulations 2020 - Whats new/Important !!

1. Schedule 2020

- 9 & 10 May : Hengelo - Holland
- 3, 4 & 5 July : Imatra - Finland
- 24, 25 & 26 July : Chimay - Belgium
- 15 & 16 August : Horice - Czech Republic
- 19 & 20 September : Frohburg - Germany

2. Training

To qualify for the race, a rider must achieve a time during one of the qualifying sessions at least equal to 115% of the average qualifying time recorded by the fastest 3 riders of his class.

3. Races

If there is a restart, every IRRC-race must have at least 5 laps.

4. Technical Inspection

Sparebikes may be presented for inspection, but a sparebike is forbidden in the pitlane at all times.

When a sparebike is in the pitlane, a penalty of 3 places retrogradation in training or race will be given.

5. Start-numbering

The first 3 riders in the final standings of IRRC-Supersport and IRRC-Superbike season 2019, are given priority to drive with the following starting numbers:

IRRC-SSP: #1 Matthieu Lagrive, #2 Laurent Hoffmann, #3 Christian Schmitz

IRRC-SBK: #1 Davey Todd, #2 Didier Grams, #3 Marek Cerveny

!!! No Fantasy will be allowed. The colours must be respected !!!

Superbike: white background with black number



Supersport: white background with blue number



All numbers have to be readable from a distance.

6. Subscription "International Road Racing Championship 2020"

Riders can fill in the "Application Championship IRRC 2020" or "Application Guest rider IRRC 2020" on the website of IRRC.

The entry fee for "IRRC Championship 2020" is 1.200 €.

7. Payment

The prices for Daily Classification will be paid 1 week after the event on the bankaccount mentioned by the rider on his application.
